#### Menu Explanations

<u>Wheel Bearing Inspection:</u> We will remove all wheel bearings, clean, inspect and repack with new grease. Then reinstall with new seals, clean brakes, and test/adjust brake system. You do not want to be left on the side of the road. Perform yearly or 12000 miles whichever comes first on ALL towable RV's.

<u>Suspension/Brake Check:</u> We check the axle springs and shackles and perform brake operation spin check and adjustment. Perform between wheel bearing service, every 6 months.

<u>Roof Tune-Up:</u> Have the roof inspected yearly and seal small voids and cracks by an RV technician. It is better to do a little each year than a lot in the future or when you get a leak. The owner should perform a visual inspection every 90 days. Manufactures only warranty sealants for the 1<sup>st</sup> 90 days of ownership.

<u>Air Conditioner Performance Test:</u> We clean the evaporator coils, cooling fins and filter. We then test A/C output temperature. (New filters are additional if needed)

<u>LP Leak Test and Regulator Lock-up Test:</u> Twice yearly in the first year, then every year there after you should perform this test as small leaks only get bigger.

<u>Gas Appliance Tune-up or Cleaning:</u> Yearly you should clean the burner assemblies in the gas appliances; this is the first step in troubleshooting failure of these appliances. So, stay on top of them. Perform the Annual Inspection so an RV Technician can identify any problems.

<u>Peace of Mind Maintenance Package:</u> We will perform a peace of mind inspection for our customers. We will perform an LP leak check, operate all appliances, service/test batteries and check 12- and 100-volt electrical system, lubricate stabilizers, steps, door and compartment locks. This is good idea to perform yearly to avoid any reliability issues.

<u>Winterize and De-winterize</u>: This is a must to avoid costly damage to your unit. We will drain the freshwater system, drain and by-pass water heater, then flush the system with RV antifreeze. When dewinterizing we will reverse the above and flush/pressure test water system. Do this with and annual system check out.

<u>Endless Warranty:</u> For those who have this awesome program, you must have it inspected yearly. If anything is noticed that needs attention, we will let you know first.

Slide-Room Maintenance: We will check the adjustment, inspect/lubricate slide seals.

<u>Clean and Wax Coach:</u> This fiberglass material needs cleaned yearly and then apply wax to protect the coach from fading. Can be done by owner. See parts for cleaners.

<u>Clean and Treat the Roof:</u> Roof material needs protectant applied and after cleaning is a good time for this, perform this yearly. The owner can do this. See parts for supplies needed.

Electric Brake Controller: Test brake controller and 7 pin wiring on tow vehicle.

Equalizer and Fifth Wheel Adjustment: When purchasing a new tow vehicle make sure you have the hitch adjusted by a professional RV Technician.

The above maintenance will meet or exceed your manufactures requirement for warranty.
